



DORIS DUKE HISTORIC PRESERVATION AWARDS



A joint program of the Newport Restoration Foundation and the City of Newport, the annual Doris Duke Historic Preservation Awards encourages exemplary historic preservation efforts within the City of Newport, Rhode Island by recognizing and rewarding activities or accomplishments that strengthen, broaden and advance the appreciation, understanding and involvement in historic preservation in Newport.

AWARD CRITERIA AND NOMINATION PROCESS

- Eligible recipients: individuals; non-profit or for-profit entities; federal, state or local agencies. The owner of the building or site is the official recipient. Properties that are listed for sale will not be considered.
- All project and site work must have been completed within the last three years.
- The committee encourages and will consider a wide variety of project types, from small buildings to large, landscapes or streetscapes, education or advocacy projects, sustainable “green building” preservation, or projects showcasing craftsmanship/artisanship.
- Nominees may be considered over three annual cycles.
- Recipients may only receive one award in one category per year.
- As many as three awards may be granted each year with the awards committee reserving the right to designate additional awards under extraordinary circumstances.

We invite you to participate in the best of historic preservation within the City of Newport, Rhode Island by nominating individuals or organizations whose contributions demonstrate outstanding excellence in historic preservation and are deserving of a Doris Duke Historic Preservation Award.
