Policy on Motorcoaches and Full-Size Buses at Rough Point

Due to zoning regulations, and agreements with the City of Newport and various neighbors, Rough Point is not accessible to motor coaches: neither on the property nor discharging and boarding from the street on Bellevue Avenue.

For both logistical and legal reasons, Newport Restoration Foundation will not allow vehicles with capacities larger than 36 people (or over 32' long) onto the property, or dropping off in front of the property.

Mini-coaches and other vehicles that hold up to 36 passengers are permitted, as are regular cars, trucks, and vans. Viking trolleys (or similar vehicles), which hold 30 passengers, are permitted.

Although we regret any inconvenience that this may cause, there are no exceptions to this policy. It is a matter of legal obligation and is in accordance with a mandate from our Board of Trustees. If this policy is violated the Foundation is subject to the loss of the special use permit that allows us to keep Rough Point open to the public.
