## Policy for Photography or Filming at Newport Restoration Museum Properties

Permission is not given to private individuals to use, for publishing in any form, their own equipment for photography or filming within the museums, Samuel Whitehorne House or Rough Point. This policy governs professional photography or filming within the museums or on their exteriors.

- In special circumstances only, and subject to receipt by the applicant of prior written approval by Newport Restoration Foundation (NRF), in NRF's sole discretion, photography or filming may be arranged.
   Applications must be fully detailed, and should particularly state the equipment, personnel and facilities involved. Submission of the application contract obligates the applicant to abide by the terms of this policy, and to the payment of the stated fees.
- 2. Photography and filming are permitted only under supervision by NRF staff. All costs for this supervision and any other disturbance costs, are charged directly to the applicant in addition to any fees involved.
- 3. Accredited professional photographers only may be commissioned by the publisher.
- 4. Principals and applicants will be required to fully compensate NRF for any damage to artifacts, art works, buildings, or equipment and for any injury to staff members, visitors, or other persons directly or indirectly caused by or attributable to the photography or filming undertaken. In addition, principals and applicants agree to indemnify NRF against any loss related to said damage or injury.
- 5. No pictures or works of art can be unframed or unmounted for photographic purposes. Works may be handled only by NRF staff.
- 6. Works on exhibition must be photographed where they are displayed. All works, wherever located, may not be touched or moved and all persons involved in filming or photographing in the museums are subject to the control and direction of the NRF staff at all times.
- 7. Works on loan to the museums may not be included in any photograph or film, directly or indirectly.
- 8. The maximum lighting permitted is equal to a total of 4,000 watts, at a distance of no less than 8 feet, and a maximum duration of 2 minutes. Electronic flash is permitted. No lighting equipment is available at the museums, and equipment using more than 15 amps may not be used without making special arrangements in advance and paying all additional charges for electrical and related services.
